Thank you for your interest in Bass Connections. The deadline for applications is February 12, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. The first two sections of this application will collect basic background information from you, including a resume. You will then have the opportunity to apply to up to three project teams. You do not have to apply to three teams – you should only apply to those teams that are of genuine interest to you. For each project that you apply to, you will be asked to complete two additional short answer questions specific to your interest in that project (1,500 characters each).

You do not have to complete your application in one-sitting. You may save your work up until you complete essay responses for your first choice project team and return at a later date; **however, you must return to the survey using the same browser on the same computer** (we recommend using a personal computer for this reason). After you complete essay responses for your first choice team, you will not be able edit prior responses, but you can still exit and return to your in-progress survey at any time.

First round decisions will be made in early March; some students may remain on the wait-list at this point. All students will receive final notification by no later than the end of March.

Note: For students receiving need-based financial aid who participate in Bass Connections project teams in the summer for six or more weeks, Duke will assume either partial or full responsibility for the "summer earnings" requirement.
