Figure 1: North Carolina Companies in the Aerospace Industry by NAICS

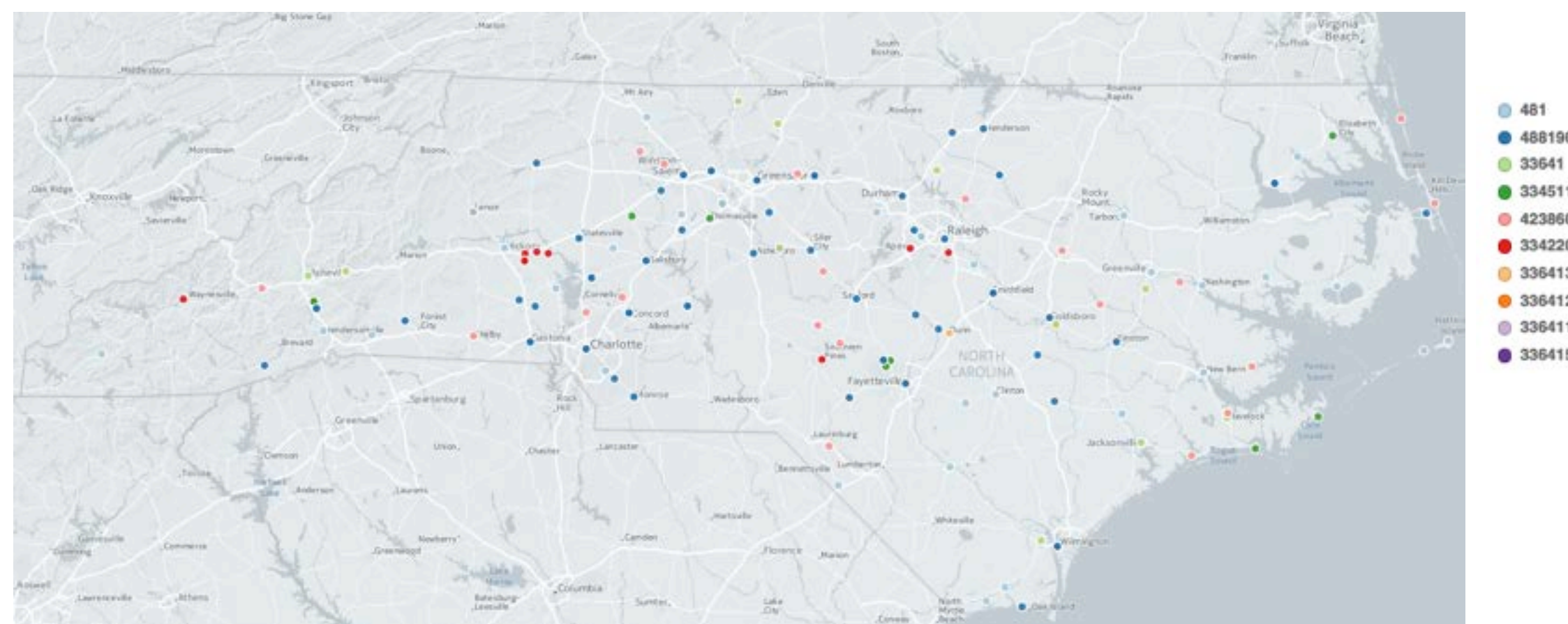


Figure 2: North Carolina Companies in the Aerospace Industry by Sales

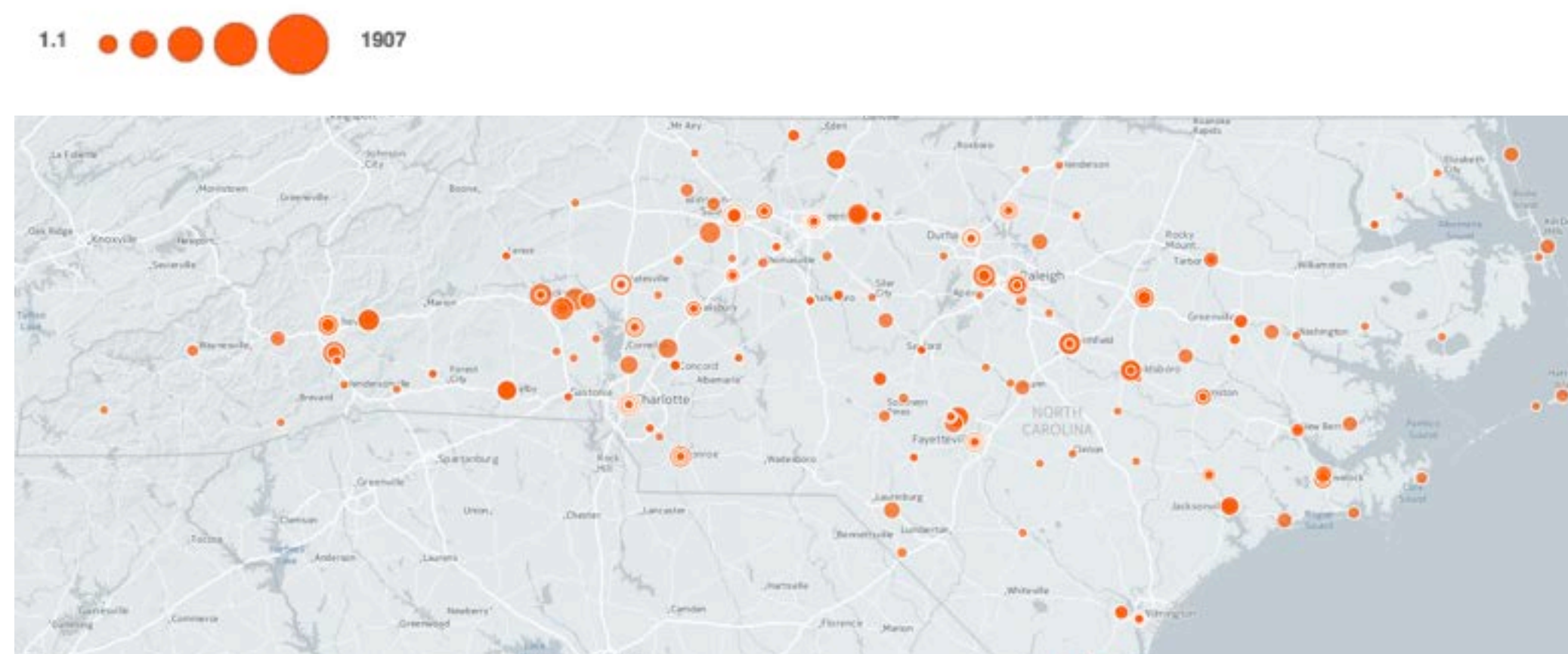


Figure 3: North Carolina Aerospace Value Chain, 2012

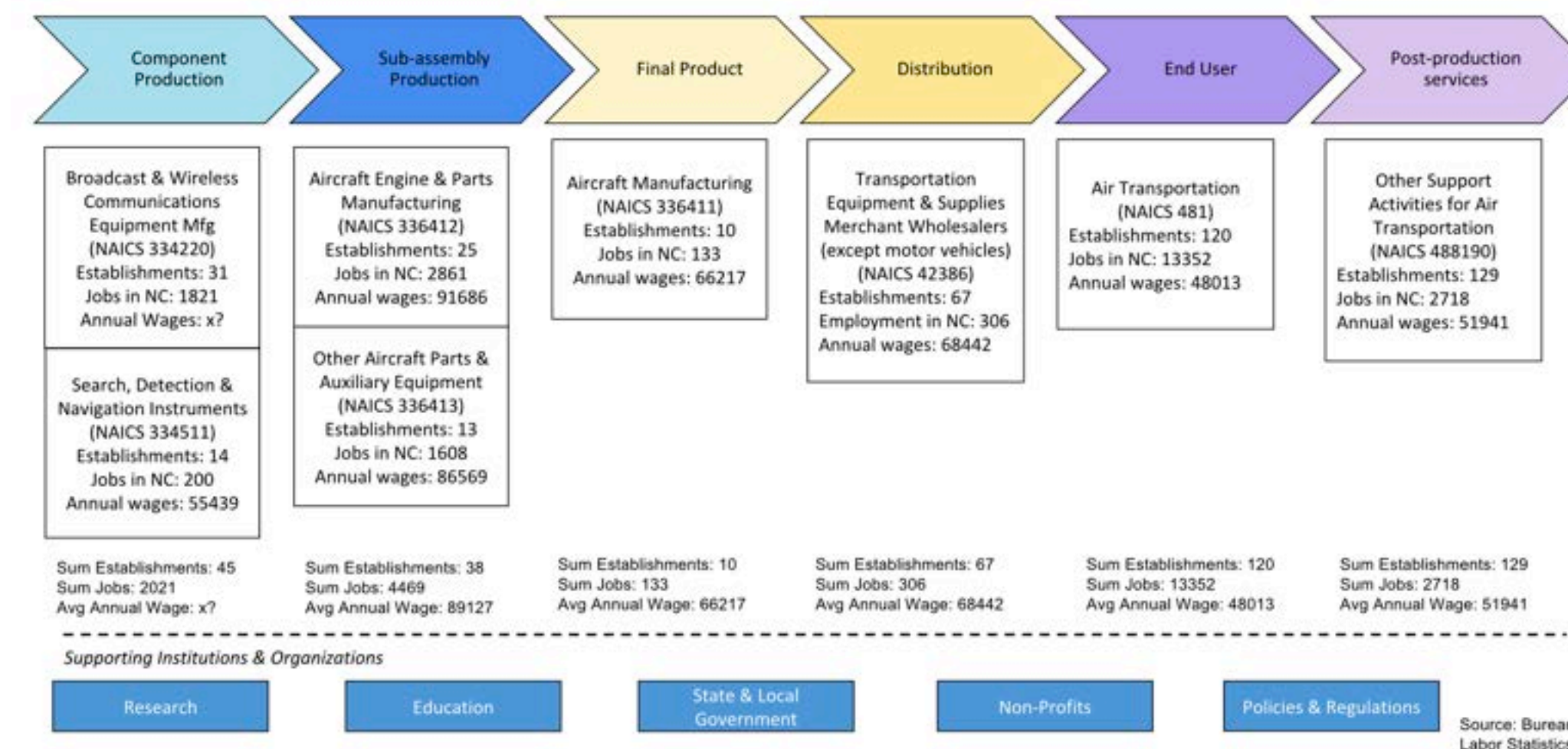


Figure 4: Percentage Change of Jobs and Establishments in North Carolina's Aerospace Industry, 2007-2012
