












Durham's Response

Low-Income Homeowners Relief Program (LIHR)



Social Services

Objectives:

- Reduce financial hardship of rising property taxes
- Maintain homeownership & remain stably housed

Qualifications:

- 5-year residence in current house
- Income ≤ 80% AMI

Savings:

• Range: \$250-\$4,000

• Average: \$1,000



Research Question

How does a new, local property tax relief program mitigate the effects of rising property taxes and other neighborhood changes on lowincome homeowners?

Methods

Between January 2023-April 2024...

- 1. Called, texted, and emailed 121 LIHR applicants.
- 2. Conducted 40 interviews over Zoom or phone.
- 3. Distributed \$1,600 in \$40 gift cards to interviewees.



Findings

- 1. LIHR is helpful and accessible.
- Households with tightening budgets express crucial relief.
- Application portal is user-friendly and streamlined.

2. Communication is a challenge.

- Express uncertainty on relief status.
- Lack of communication leads to late fees or double payments.

3. Durham life remains difficult.

- Critical home fixes deferred.
- Increased utilities stretch budgets.
- Other homes in city considered unaffordable.

4. Participants want more from local government.

- Feel unheard on local policy issues.
- Want improved sidewalks and lessened crime.

"There's **no** catch. I went online, you know...it was quite easy."

So then there's this limbo period, and you don't know what the hell's happening.

"Selling the house is simply not an option. I need to be here because I can't afford anything else here."

"We've got a sidewalk down our street... And then the one street over has got no sidewalks at all."
